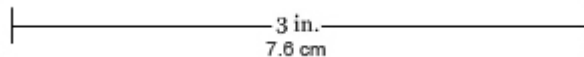


Determining Your Ring Size

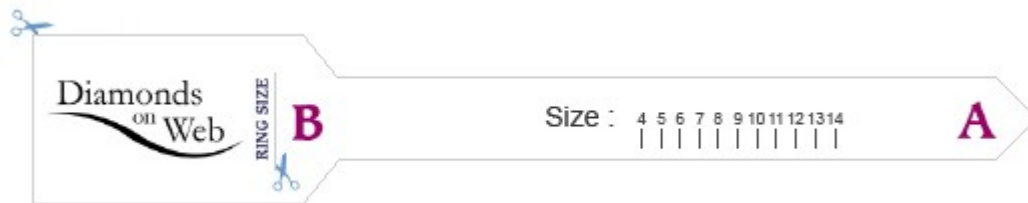
Method A: Paper Ring Sizer

Print out this page and just make sure that your printing settings are set to print at a scale of 100%.

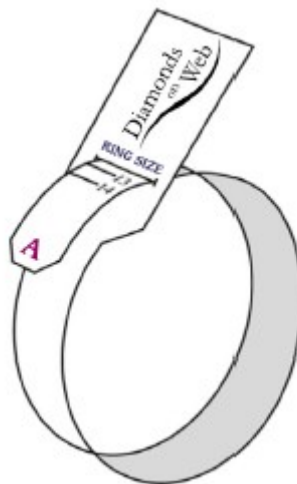
Double check that the print out is to scale by using measuring tape or a ruler to verify that the line below is in fact 3 inches (7.6 cm) long.



Cut out the ring sizer below and be sure to also cut a small slit along the dotted line marked "B".



Wrap the sizer around the finger being measured, ensuring that the numbers are facing out. Then simply pull "A" through Slot "B" until the sizer is snug.



The number aligned with slot "B" is your ring size. If slot "B" falls between two numbers, order the size between the two numbers.

Determining Your Ring Size

Method B: Measure Current Ring

Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger.

Place the ring over the circles below, matching the inside size of the ring to the circle nearest in size.

Size 3 14.0 mm	Size 3.5 14.4 mm	Size 4 14.8 mm	Size 4.5 15.2 mm
Size 5 15.8 mm	Size 5.5 16.0 mm	Size 6 16.45 mm	Size 6.5 16.9 mm
Size 7 17.3 mm	Size 7.5 17.7 mm	Size 8 18.2 mm	Size 8.5 18.6 mm
Size 9 19.0 mm	Size 9.5 19.4 mm	Size 10 19.8 mm	
Size 10.5 20.2 mm	Size 11 20.6 mm	Size 11.5 21.0 mm	Size 12 21.4 mm
Size 12.5 21.8 mm	Size 13 22.2 mm	Size 13.5 22.6 mm	

If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.
